



AT THE UNIQUE CASA SOL, A MODERN LANDSCAPE IS BUILT AROUND DROUGHT-TOLERANT, ORNAMENTAL GRASSES.

Ornamental grasses can provide rich texture, flowing movement and an elegant, modern look to the landscape. They can also be a great drought-tolerant alternative to the traditional lawn. In the fall and winter, colors fade to hues of brown, auburn and gold while the seedheads add both ornamental value and food for wildlife. The wood slats of the Casa Sol and the pavers that surround it highlight permeability of light and water in the landscape. The fine blades of ornamental grasses provide a graceful complement to the modern home design.

The landscape design at Casa Sol is dominated by sweeps of native grasses such as Little Bluestem, Sideoats Grama Grass and Pine Muhly Grass. Perennial wildflowers such as Shrubby Blue Sage and Autumn Sage are interplanted, providing splashes of color among the grasses. Large specimen plants such as Mexican Buckeye and Nelson's Nolina provide focal points in the landscape.
